1. Apologies

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

It was agreed that minutes were true and correct and were signed off by the Chairperson.

3. Public Forum

There were no members of the public present.

4. Rangers Visit

Hedge cutting round South End signage, cleaning Mill Lane, North End noticeboard on the list for the Rangers' next visit. AS to chase up site visit of soak away in Holly Lodge Farmhouse paddock. JR reported on findings made by naturalists around verges on Snetterton/Hargham border and their request for verges to be cut later to avoid upsetting breeding cycles. JR to request a paper from naturalists re. timings to pass on to Council. DH to add cutting of village field to the Rangers' list.

5. Circuit Liaison Group

HF has notified the Circuit of TW's resignation and will represent Snetterton PC. Fireworks event details to be added to PC website. HF to ask AH.

6. Bio-mass Liaison Meeting

7. Speeding on Sallow Lane

HF reported that conversations with SA and Highways representative re Sallow Lane and no signage / flashing speed reminder is permitted in a 60 m.p.h. zone. After discussion it was agreed that HF would investigate mirrors to be fixed at cross road on Sallow Lane and cross road at North End.

8. Noticeboards

HF to ask Rob Mann to quote to mend noticeboards.

9. Twinning

HF reported that she would contact the Circuit to sound out their view on the Twinning.

10. Finances

HF to contact Lesley at Robert Plumbly's office re. cheque book. HF to check with DH whether there are any signed cheques. New banking arrangements to be progressed.

11. AOB

HF reported that LH had resigned from the council due to ill health. A casual vacancy has therefore arisen on the Parish Council and HF together with AS will look to fill via co-option.

HF reported on PC's District Councillor's Report. Local Plan will come before council in March, following six week consultation. Breckland has a sustainable budget and healthy reserves.
