2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

It was agreed that minutes were true and correct and were signed off by the Chairperson.

3. Public Forum

After some discussion re. the introduction of signage and parishioners having concluded that it has made no difference to traffic calming on Sallow Lane, SA agreed that he would write to Highways and see if we can get a 40 mph limit on built up part of the lane going into 30 mph limit.

4. District Councillors Report

PC reported on progress of Local Plan. Report expected following meetings with officers 30.2.2019. Local Plan adoption anticipated in June / July. Hopeful of no planning danger to Snetterton before then.

PC outlined two good local apps Shopappy and BreckWorld. Agreed that we should add these resources' availability to the Snetterton Parish Council website.

Finally PC confirmed that Council Taxes would be set in February 2019 and that Norfolk Council had a good, balanced budget in place for the next five years.

5. Parish Clerk Vacancy

HF informed the meeting that she and AS had had a preliminary meeting with Julian Gibson who had expressed interest in becoming our Clerk. PC commented that he has worked with him on other councils and found him very thorough. He recommended him as did SA.

6. Twinning

HF confirmed that following her and AS meeting at Snetterton Race Track and their

approval of the concept of the Twinning she had received no response to her letter to the Catalanian town subsequent to her letter.

7. Finances

HF reported a healthy Bank balance and that she was dealing with Lloyds Bank re. signatory issue, following RP's death. It was agreed that we would apply for a £2500 precept for 2019.

8. AOB

Nomination papers have been circulated to Council members and need to be completed and returned to Dereham.
