24/23	Cllr Skinner was elected unopposed as lady chairman for the year 2023-24 proposed Cllr Mason seconded Cllr Ellis
25/23	Apologies received from Cllr Hempsall
26/23	No declarations were made
27/23	The minutes of the meeting held on 17 th April were agreed proposed Cllr Ellis, seconded Cllr Mason
28/23	Updates 1. the 1st consultation on the local plan update will close on 19/5/23 Cllr Suggitt reported on the background of the plan and the constraints that the district council operates under. 2. Cllr Skinner asked any residents that are having any problems with county broadband to contact her, she will raise the issue again with the MP. 3. It was noted that trees had been felled in the village without the permission of the owners.
29/23	Defibrillator – It was agreed that, Natures menu, The dogs trust and Bio mass will be contacted seeking funding assistance.
30/23	Planning – no objections, but a request that highways concerns, and environmentally sensitive lighting is conditioned
31/23	Finance – all items agreed unanimously proposed Cllr Skinner seconded Cllr Ellis
32/23	Councillor and chairmanship training was offered but declined by all councillors present
33/23	Shropham and Snetterton Grove, call for volunteers. None received
34/23	County councillor – no report
35/23	Cllr Suggitt reported on the district councils continued efforts to help vulnerable people including initiatives like the food bus and advice. She went on to explain the new political balance of the district council, and congratulate new councillors. Cllr Suggitt offered her continued support to the parish council.
