

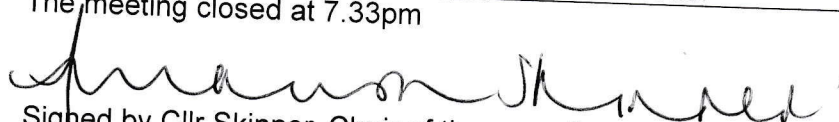
SNETTERTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting of the council Held on 11th March 2024

Present – Cllr Skinner (chair), Cllr Watkins, Cllr Ellis, Cllr Hemsall,
Cllr Mason. Cllr Askew (NCC) and 2 members of the public

14/24	No apologies were recieved
15/24	No declarations were made
16/24	The minutes of the meeting held on 29 th January were agreed as a true record proposed Cllr Hemsall seconded Cllr Watkins
17/24	As instructed by the chair, agenda item 6 (report by County Councillor) was moved up the agenda to be discussed at this point. Cllr Askew submitted a written report and agreed to report back on mitigation measures that could be available to prevent further flooding issues throughout the village, including the responsibility of landowners. He also agreed to highlight numerous potholes to highways dept' for their action. Cllr Askew will arrange a meeting between the himself, parish and district councillors to discuss plans to develop the land at Noth End, and input to the local plan.
18/24	Public participation No matters were raised by the attending members of the public
19/24	No report was received from district councillors
20/24	Updates- 1. Defibrillator, as funding offers have now been received from Fairfax & Favor and the agri' mill. The council will now move forward and place an order for a defibrillator to be sited at the World horse welfare gate. 2. Race track meeting to discuss sound nuisance, this meeting has not yet taken place. 3. Free library, an update will be made when more progress has been made on this. 4. Light nuisance from industrial site, Cllr Mason will report on this at the next meeting. It is expected that Travis Perkins will be suggested for a dark sky award from CPRE, to be considered at the next meeting.
21/24	Local validation list, the councillors raised issues that will be submitted to BDC for consideration.
22/24	Planning, the council had made no comments on planning applications
23/24	Finance – payments approved proposed Cllr Skinner seconded Cllr Hemsall
24/24	The council reviewed the following polices and agreed unanimously that they should remain unchanged. 1. Standing orders 2. Code of conduct 3. Financial regulations 4. Information and data protection 5. Delegated authority to clerk in respect of planning applications Proposed Cllr Skinner, seconded Cllr Mason
25/24	The next meeting of the council will be on 20 th May <u>note the venue next meeting will be Holly Lodge Farmhouse this meeting will follow the annual parish meeting and is scheduled for 6.30pm</u>
26/24	The council then moved into private session (proposed Cllr Hemsall seconded Cllr Mason) to discuss a confidential issue.
